UCF AND TEXAS TECH TO CO-HOST ISLEWORTH COLLEGIATE INVITATIONAL

WINDERMERE, Florida – The University of Central Florida joins Texas Tech University in hosting the 2011 Isleworth Collegiate Invitational. The eighth annual college golf tournament will be held at Isleworth Golf & Country Club Oct. 23 - 25, 2011.

Isleworth has been the site of the Isleworth Collegiate Invitational since 2004, when UCF and Tavistock Group partnered to develop a tournament designed to give collegiate players and coaches the feel of a PGA Tour event. UCF played host to the tournament for the next four years until Texas Tech became host in 2008.

Recognized as one of the premier college golf competitions in the nation, the Isleworth Collegiate Invitational offers collegiate golfers the opportunity to play on one of the toughest courses in the nation against the best players in the game.

Each year, the three-day tournament invites 15 of the nation's top collegiate golf teams to compete for the coveted title. Powerhouse teams that annually make the trip to Isleworth include the University of Alabama, the University of Florida, the University of Georgia, Oklahoma State University, Stanford University and the University of Texas. Former Isleworth Collegiate Invitational players include J.B. Holmes, Rickie Fowler, Jamie Lovemark, Webb Simpson and Jhonattan Vegas.

Isleworth is a par-72, 7,544-yard championship course originally designed by Arnold Palmer and Ed Seay, and later redesigned and enhanced by Steve Smyers. Isleworth regularly ranks as one of the longest and most difficult courses in the state of Florida and is home to a number of world-renowned PGA professionals.
